The race: Average tempo, though having Joyful Champion (YL Chung) working forward outside the leaders does have some potential to add extra pace if he gets caught wide and decides to push on. Expect the inside 4 runners all to be looking for handy positions early without seeking the lead, and Gang Of Brothers and Fearless Fire will be looking to get around them in the early stages.

Recommendations: Tough race and not getting too involved but opposing Fearless Fire and M Unicorn at the prices. WIN WIN FIGHTER had race circumstances against him last 2 since drop to C4 but gone ok. Blkr on here. 1 unit. JOYFUL GENIUS won well enough at Sha Tin and maps to get right run again. 1 unit. GALLANT CROWN back to C4 for first time in 2 years and has won 4 races this c/d. Hasn't been flying in C3 lately but did win in that class early in the season and this maps well. 1.5 units.

The race: Just can't see a lot of pressure here, with the speed engaged from the inside 4 barriers and therefore all the pace runners will get to good places quickly and won't have a fight for positions. Cheer For You looks clearly the fastest horse in the race and the only possibility of a stronger pace would be My Intelligent trying to hold him out? Not convinced My Intelligent is fast enough and, if that contest doesn't happen, Teetan will have the option to steady the lead midrace. Red Desert has been conservatively-ridden from wide draws recently though he does have a bit of speed – maybe his plan might be to begin well then try to slot over behind the speed rather than drag back to last? Crown Of Star a wild card as shown a little early speed in 2 trials since his last race but he hasn't been best of beginners on race day? Although we have been seeing Snowalot getting back near last recently, he may be a little closer here as he should find the rail quickly once the inside horses have gone ahead.

Recommendations: Another race where it's a struggle to get too involved. The Runner is back to C4, a 5-time winner this c/d with Purton going on and a nice map. Just don't think he'll beny sort of price. ALWAYS FLUKE disappointing l/s Sha Tin after running good race debut HV 1000m. Perhaps he prefers HV? Had a change of trainer to KW Lui for this. 1 unit. RED DESERT hasn't mapped well last 2 since drop into C4, doesn't map well again but will be a backable price to compensate. 0.5 unit.

The race: Calling this average tempo but it's very tricky and could swing either way. It has a bit of a look about it that the pace could be busy in the early stages then slow right up midrace once they all find their positions. Although Master Tornado has led this c/d previously, he did that from an inside draw with a light weight in C3 when there was no speed in the race, and now he has the outside gate, big weight with th class drop and it's up for discussion whether he is the fastest horse. Ready Player One was close to the lead l/s in well-run race in April this c/d and that's probably faster early speed but he has never really gone looking for the front and might use his speed to get across then let something else lead him? Also, out wide we have potential pace runners in United Endeavors and Singapore Spirit (YL Chung) and even Happy Hunk went forward l/s this c/d, though from gate 2 in a modest tempo? And if it wasn't already muddy, Big Two did lead this c/d one night when he drew low like this & Beauty Mission is probably looking to be handier early tonight as he was slow to begin l/s.

Recommendations: Pace is important here for LEAN HERO but appeals as a good bet here, over the c/d where this 3yo won well in Dec. Didn't get the right race shape l/s, when leader Chrysos set a very soft tempo for first half then sprinted hard from the 700m and it was difficult to make ground, even more so with track was assisting on-pace runners. There are some queries on the tempo here but if it is more consistent think it will suit this horse who has some upside. 5.5 units. READY PLAYER ONE has a great chance after good runs first 2 starts since move to Richards. The negative is that he was scratched with a leg injury on May 2 and missed a few gallops, though has trialled ok 2 weeks ago. 2 units.

The race: Might fall short of average tempo but calling it that simply because the nailed-on leader Colonel, with the 7-pound claimer on, has drawn gate 10 so he will have to be used a little to try to cross the field. Whether he gets much opposition in that is probably up to Fighting Star or Golden Luck. Golden Luck draws a better gate and gets a jockey upgrade to Purton after showing some speed in his 4 runs to date, though he has also been a bit keen so that might impact just how much Purton wants to use him early – he may be happy to take the box seat cover behind the leader? See U Again has not been ridden for speed in recent runs wider draws but does have speed and gets a more aggressive rider tonight but he was in no hurry early recent trial & perhaps will be negative again here from a wide draw? Giving King Invincible the benefit of the doubt at the start after he jumped well l/s and was not far away over 1000m but he has generally not been a great beginner before that?

Recommendations: KING INVINCIBLE rated well at first 2 starts HV 1000m after moderate starts then thought he was a bit disappointing l/s that c/d after beginning cleanly, getting a fast pace to run at and only plodded. However, that was the May 17 meeting when the track was quite dodgy, he might now prefer the tempo of 1200m. Overlooking l/s makes him clear fav despite map not being ideal. 2 units. SIGHT HERO flying, ran on against the bias l/s this c/d. Tricky map. 1 unit. CHEONG FAT another going well but nothing in his favour on the map for a horse who doesn't begin brilliantly and will get back. 1.5 units. FIGHTING STAR 0.5 unit.

The race: Soft tempo. Hard to see much of a race for the lead here, with Satirical Glory as likely a frontrunner as any but won't be trying to set much of a gallop. Majestic Victory has been fairly positive In his last 2 starts this c/d from wide draws, he draws better here and expect he either sits outside Satirical Glory or makes a bid for the front himself. Hit The Shot isn't that quick & comes back in distance but is usually somewhere around the speed and that looks the preferred tactic in this race anyway. Pegasus General and Comet Splendido sit in behind the speed without having any desire to lead themselves, and the rest don't have much of a pace profile.

Recommendations: Another tough race but happy to keep taking on Rocket Spade at short prices and this looks a lot like the race where SATIRICAL GLORY was narrowly beaten 4 starts ago this c/d and he has since been contesting the front In fast tempo races and weakening. Can improve sharply. 1.5 units. On face value HIT THE SHOT had his chance for Purton l/s beaten in photo Sha Tin 2000m and now has a negative jockey change to Hamelin. Nevertheless, was beaten only a head, will be rolling forward on the pace again in race where that looks suited and getting a much better price this time. 3 units. S J TOURBILLON has gone too soon twice, HV 2200m and Sha Tin 2000m, in his last 3 starts and run very well without winning. Not as well drawn tonight but racing well enough to win one. 2 units.

The race: Average tempo. Atomic Energy (YL Chung) will no doubt come outlooking to press and while the scratching of Harmony And Rich has removed some speed from the race, not sure it has made things that much easier for Atomic Energy to get there. With Harmony And Rich in the race, perhaps his stablemate Harmony N Blessed would have happily taken a sit, which seems to be a new play with him. But with just the of them pressing forward low in the draw, perhaps Harmony N Blessed will make more of an attempt to hold the rail? Harmony Fire still has the pace to be a potential speed influence from the wide draw and perhaps he will press forward hoping that Atomic Energy does clear the inside runners and bring him across. Seasons Wit is not the cleanest of beginners but likely takes up the trailing spot behind the leaders. Equaletta Blitz always a bit of a ix as to his positioning but, with a good draw and relatively-light weight, expect he would like to be poised behind the frontrunners too.

Recommendations: Hard to go past Seasons Wit as the right favourite, the worry is the price of a clear favourite ridden by Purton for Richards. GORGEOUS VITALITY continues to be over the odds in these races & continues to not get much of a trip in his races. Chadwick managed to be caught wide at the tail of the field from gate 6 l/s so we'll see what he can come up with here from the outside barrier. Horses have also had difficulty running on at HV last few meetings but all those concerns offset by getting a very big price if it falls into place. 2.5 units.
